

CROSS-CONNECTION PERMIT

As of August 31, 2004, any cross-connection installed on a water line belonging to Aqua Water Supply Corporation (Aqua WSC) requires a permit. The property owner must apply for a cross-connection permit in Aqua WSC's Customer Service office and pay a permit fee of \$25.00 at the time of the application.

Upon installation of the Backflow Prevention Assembly, the owner must submit a Backflow Prevention Assembly Test and Maintenance Report to Aqua WSC as required by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). Only a licensed Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester (BPAT) may complete the test and report for the backflow prevention device. You may obtain a list of licensed testers by contacting Aqua WSC or TCEQ.

Also as of August 31, 2004, Aqua WSC will begin requiring all testable backflow devices to be retested every three (3) years for non-health issues and annually for health issues. Aqua WSC will email or mail a notice when it is time to retest the backflow device, and the member must submit a new Backflow Prevention Assembly Test and Maintenance Report.

Commercial facilities are required to have containment protection at the meter, in the form of a Reduced Pressure (RP) assembly, to safeguard against cross-connections. However, this measure does not replace the need for proper internal backflow protection within the facility.
