Planning for Your Family's Future

Planning for an uncertain future can be challenging at times, but this is a vital part of what we do at Aqua Water Supply. To ensure that we will have sufficient resources to meet the needs of our membership for years to come, we strive to invest wisely in improvements to benefit all the families and businesses that rely on us for their water supply.

Following is the latest news related to some strategic projects that we have been working to finalize. Joining Forces

Aqua Water is pleased to announce the successful completion of a merger with the Polonia Water Supply Corporation (WSC) in Lockhart. Talks began several years ago in response to the shared need for sustainable water supply sources to keep up with rapid growth throughout Central Texas.

After Polonia cooperative members approved the merger in October of 2020, we began working on the required tasks to complete the merger, which was officially closed on August 15, 2022. Five Polonia WSC employees opted to join our staff.

At the time of the merger, the Polonia system was serving more than 3,200 meter connections. The costs to operate and maintain the Polonia water system are covered by the customers in that service area, so there are no additional costs for Aqua to manage the system. However, with the increase in net revenue and economies of scale from the merger, Aqua expects to be better positioned to continue making improvements to the combined overall water system.

The Aqua water supply system now covers nearly 30,000 connections serving approximately 75,000 people. Our service area spans six Texas counties covering roughly 1,400 square miles.

Room to Grow

When we began merger talks, Polonia WSC was in the process of building a new elevated storage tank and pump station. Aqua has assumed management of those projects and now the new storage tank is nearly complete.

Work on the Pittman storage tank in Caldwell County began last September. Earlier this month a final coating was applied to the 500,000-gallon tank, which will increase water pressure reliability in parts of the newly acquired service area.

At Aqua we are committed to serving the changing needs of our members in a sensible, sustainable, responsible manner. We continue to update our longterm vision for the Central Texas region, following a strategic plan to guide capital investments in order to stay ahead of growth, to deliver first-rate service for all the members in our expanding service area.

In response to continued drought conditions throughout the region, Aqua Water has moved from Stage 2 to Stage 1 of our Drought Contingency Plan. Current water use restrictions are voluntary; however, we encourage all members to conserve water whenever possible as a best practice.

As part of the Stage 1 water use restrictions, Aqua requests water customers to voluntarily limit the irrigation of landscaped areas to the following watering schedule.


Monday and Thursday:

Even last number of address

Tuesday and Friday:

Odd last number of address.





Outdoor watering is restricted to mornings before 10:00 a.m., and evenings after 7:00 p.m. on the appropriate watering day based on your house address. Please limit outdoor watering to no more than one inch.
